Citizens group planning initiative push

A bipartisan group of concerned citizens seeking to prevent the Medina County Courthouse from being torn down and replaced without a vote of the people will gather at noon Wednesday in front of the courthouse.

The Save Your Courthouse Committee is circulating an initiative petition, which will require a majority vote of the citizens of Medina before the city can fund or participate in the project. The estimated to cost for is new courthouse is more than \$40 million. The committee will hold the socially-safe gathering to renew attention to the fact that the Medina County commissioners and Medina City Council are continuing with the project, even in these economically uncertain times.

Any Medina city registered voter who wants to sign the initiative petition can safely sign in several of the following ways:

■ Stop by the courthouse Wednesday. Circulators will wear masks and maintain a socially safe distance from signatures.

■ Come to a drive-thru service. Every Thursday from 5-7 p.m., every Saturday from 1-4 p.m. and every Sunday from 1-4 p.m., through the end of June, there will be a drive-thru for signing the petition behind 231 South Broadway St., across from Garfield Elementary School. Look for the red "Sign Court-house Petition Here" sign.

■ Call (330) 722-5567 to arrange to sign while maintaining a safe social distance. If the committee is able to obtain a sufficient number of

signatures, the measure will be placed on the November ballot.
